Multitranche Financing Facility for the Sustainable Coastal Protection and Management Investment Program Maharashtra Maritime Board

Invitation for Submission of Expressions of Interest (EOI) for Project Management and Design Consultants - Maharashtra

1. India has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for Sustainable Coastal Protection and Management Investment Program in the states of Maharashtra, Goa and Karnataka. Program includes subprojects to be taken up for immediate implementation and a long list of preliminary development proposals to be taken up for planning, design and implementation. The investment project includes proposals and programs to support long term sustainable shoreline management including institutional development and a range of structural and non structural measures (the Program). Activities will be financed through ADB's multi tranche financing facility (MFF) and part of the loan proceeds will be applied for consulting services for project management and design consultant, Maharashtra (PMDC-M).
2. The scope of services of PMDC-M, which will work closely with a multi-disciplinary PMU will be in four parts; (i) Project Management Support (ii) Support for Effective Institutions (iii) Planning and Design and (iv) Support for Implementation of Coastal Sub Projects.
3. The Maharashtra Maritime Board (MMB) intends to engage an international consulting firm. A PMU will be established within MMB. The Consultants will work with the PMU providing technical assistance for project management, institutional strengthening, planning and design, and support for subproject implementation.
4. About 39 person-months (pm) of international and 119 pm of national consultants will be required, with the consulting firm's services tentatively commencing in August 2011, for an estimated contract period of 40 months during the tranche 1 of the MFF.
5. The consulting firm will be selected and engaged in accordance with the *Guidelines on the Use of Consultants by ADB and its Borrowers (April 2010)*, and using the Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) method with full technical proposal.
6. Interested and eligible firms from ADB member countries are invited to submit EOIs including information which will demonstrate their capabilities and experiences that they are qualified to perform the required services not later than **31 January 2011** to the following address:
